Money

- For on-line deposits to an inmates account go to www.jailpayments.com.
- The Jail only accepts cash, money orders and cashiers checks.
- Money orders and cashiers checks should be made out to the inmate.
- **Personal checks are not accepted.**
- The money will be credited to the inmate's account for their use.
- The Jail staff is not allowed to share information about the inmate's account with anyone other than the inmate.
- Money will be accepted only during visitation hours or through the mail.

Telephones

- Messages are not taken for the inmates.
- If you wish to leave a message for an inmate, you can call the inmate message system at (507) 376-4203. These messages are not confidential.
- Inmates may purchase phone cards from the Jail or on-line at reliancetelephone.com
- These cards are available in the amounts of \$10 or \$20.
- Our phone system only accepts these phone cards.
- Any other phone cards do not work with our Jail phones.
- You may also set up collect calls for inmates by calling 1-800-896-3201.



Inmate Visitation By Appointment

Visiting hours at the Jail are:

Tuesday	7:00–10:00 p.m.
Thursday	9:00–11:00 a.m.
Sunday	9:00–11:00 a.m. 7:00–10:00 p.m.

- Each visitor must register to be eligible to visit. Registration applications can be picked up at the jail or on the Jail Website at the address above.
- You must **schedule your visit no later than 1 hour prior** to the visitation period you wish to visit at. You may schedule a visit by calling (507) 295-5378 or the inmate you wish to visit may schedule it for you.
- Saturday visits are available by appointment for visitors outside of a 50-mile radius.
- Efforts are made to allow visiting time for everyone.

Visiting Rules

- Registered visitors may visit up to 2 times a day and up to 4 times a week.
- Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and are allowed to visit a parent or legal guardian.
- A birth certificate or legal papers verifying guardianship must accompany the child.
- All visitors must provide photo identification.

Inmate Mail



- All mail must come through the United States Post Office.
- Only mail that comes through the Post Office will be delivered to the inmate.
- All mail is subject to inspection by Jail staff.
- The inmate may purchase stamps and envelopes at the Jail.
- The Jail does not accept stamps, envelopes, or mail, left by visitors for the inmate.

General Information

- Nobles County jail allows photos.
- These photos **MAY NOT** include gang graffiti, unclothed persons, photos with alcohol/cigarettes, or Polaroid photos.
- All religious material will be inspected by jail staff.
- Books and magazines are allowed, but only with approval of the Jail Programmer and must be donated to the jail library.
