

OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF NOBLES COUNTY, MINNESOTA

The County Board of Nobles County met in emergency session per Minnesota Statute 13D.04 Subd. 3 this 21st day of June, 2018, at 4:00 p.m. in the Board of Commissioners Room, at the Nobles County Government Center, Worthington, Minnesota. The following Commissioners were in attendance: Justin Ahlers, Matt Widboom, Robert S. Demuth and Donald Linssen. Absent: Gene Metz,

Joyce Jacobs, Emergency Management Director, advised the Board the Emergency Declaration is necessary to allow the County to respond to issues from the Rain/Flood Event of June 2018 and would allow townships to get contracts for repairs/replacements without going through the bidding process. Some cities may need to do a declaration as well.

County Board Chair, Robert S. Demuth, read Resolution 201835 County Emergency Declaration.

On a motion by Donald Linssen and seconded by Justin Ahlers, it was duly passed to adopt the following resolution number 201835:

WHEREAS, the Rain/Flood Event of June 2018 impacted the population of Nobles County, its cities and townships; and

WHEREAS, the Rain/Flood Event of June 2018 has caused a significant amount of property damage; and

WHEREAS, the Nobles County Department of Emergency Management requests the Nobles County Board of Commissioners to declare Nobles County in a STATE OF EMERGENCY for the Rain/Flood Event of June 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nobles County Board of Commissioners declares Nobles County in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from the Rain/Flood Event beginning June 20th of 2018.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned at 4:04 p.m. on a motion by Justin Ahlers and seconded by Matt Widboom.
