

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids shall be received by the County Commission of Nobles County, Minnesota, at the Nobles County Administration Office, 315 10th Street, 3rd Floor, P.O. Box 757, Worthington, Minnesota, 56187, until **1:30 P.M. on June 13, 2017** and will be publicly opened and read.

The work includes demolition, earthwork, cast in place concrete, concrete paving, masonry, site furnishings, lighting, electrical, joint sealants, irrigation, seeding, and landscaping and other Work indicated in the Contract Documents.


The bidder shall submit the proposal on the form prescribed and proposals will be rejected if they show any conditions or uncalled for alternate bids. All bids shall be on the basis of cash payment according to the terms of the bid specifications.

A resident bidder is allowed a preference as against the bid of any bidder from any other state enforcing or having a preference for resident bidders, equal to such preference.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or draft for five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, such check to be certified or issued by either a State or National bank domiciled within this State and payable to Nobles County, Minnesota, or in lieu thereof, a bid bond for ten (10) percent of the amount of the bid, such bond to be issued by a surety authorized to do business in this state payable to Nobles County, Minnesota. This sum is a guarantee that if the proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured.

Nobles County reserves the right to retain the bid security of the three lowest bidders for a period not to exceed 30 days after the date and time set for opening of the bids. Nobles County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any parts thereof.
