- 4) The estimated benefits are greater than the total estimated costs, including damages.

- 5) The proposed drainage project will be of public benefit and utility and will promote the public health.
- 6) The proposed drainage project is practicable.
- 7) The proportionate share attributable to separable maintenance as a cost to repair the system that is being improved is approved.

If Improvement project is established, the engineer is directed to proceed with plans and specifications toward the awarding of a contract.
