Establishment of Improvement if:
 - 1) The Final Engineer's Report and Viewers' Report have been made and other proceedings have been completed under Minnesota Statutes 103E.
 - 2) The reports made or amended are complete and correct.

- 3) The damages and benefits have been properly determine.
- 4) The estimated benefits are greater than the total estimated costs including damages.
- 5) The proposed drainage project will be of public utility and benefit and promote the public health.
- 6) The proposed drainage project is practicable.
- 7) The Drainage Authority approves the proportionate cost of the Improvement that would be required to repair the separable portion of the drainage system and the repair portion is allocated as repairs and assessed against all property benefitted by the entire drainage system, and the balance of the cost of the Improvement is assessed against the property benefitted by the Improvement.

If Improvement project is established, the engineer is directed to proceed with plans and specifications toward the awarding of a contract.
