 - 2) Establishment of Improvement if the following items have been met:
 - a. The Engineer’s Report and Viewers’ Report have been made and other proceedings have been completed under Minnesota Statutes 103E.
 - b. The Reports made or amended are complete and correct.
 - c. The damages and benefits have been properly determined.
 - d. The estimated benefits are greater than the total estimated costs, including damages.
 - e. The proposed drainage project will be of public benefit and utility and will promote the public health.
 - f. The proposed drainage project is practicable.
 - g. The proportionate share attributable to separable maintenance as a cost to repair the system that is being improved is approved based on the system being out of repair and the cost estimates provided by the engineer.

If the Improvement project is established, the engineer is directed to proceed with plans and specifications toward awarding of a contract.
