4.0 CARES Act Distribution	
Discussion was had between Nobles County and the City of Worthington regarding the distribution of CARES Act funding. After the first round of applications were received, a large amount of funds remain available. Different options were reviewed such as raising the amount available to small businesses, re opening the application period along with opening it to home based businesses and non-profit organizations. The City of Worthington voted to increase the tier levels 50% to now be: Tier 1: Up to \$15,000 Tier 2: Up to \$11,250 Tier 3: Up to \$7,500 Include home based businesses up to \$2,500 The City of Worthington cannot use funds for non-profits, it was decided the County would process the non-profit applications.	
<u>VOTING</u> It was duly passed to allow the City of Worthington to adjust the tier levels to the suggested amounts. Moved by: Metz, Gene Seconded by: Widboom, Matt It was duly passed to set the amount for non-profits to be up to \$2,500 with applications due by October 16, 2020. Moved by: Linssen, Donald Seconded by: Demuth, Robert S.
