RESOLUTION

A resolution expressing Worthington School District 518's concern for pedestrians and continued feedback to provide a safer crossing for students and adults at CSAH 10 (Crailsheim Drive) and CSAH 35 (Oxford Street) intersection.

WHEREAS, concerns have periodically been shared with District 518 in regards to pedestrians who cross vehicle traffic at the CSAH 10 and CSAH 35 intersection; and

WHEREAS, taxpayers and school board, alike, offer continued feedback regarding several close calls of potential accidents with pedestrians and vehicles within the aforementioned intersection; and

WHEREAS, those discussions, and potential accidents involved Worthington Middle School students/staff who crossed this intersection to access school; and


WHEREAS, this unsubstantiated evidence is not used to State-authorize additional infrastructure assistance, including stop lights or signs within the intersection, District 518 feels a more proactive approach needs to be addressed to avoid accident.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF DISTRICT 518 OF NOBLES COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

1. The school board of District 518 is requesting that Nobles County take a more proactive approach in addressing the needs of this intersection to avoid a potential accident; and
2. The school board is requesting the consideration to lower the speed around the Middle School to 25 to 30 mph and particularly to lower the speed of vehicles coming from the West to a farther distance; and
3. The school board is requesting that Nobles County consider installing stop signs at this intersection to control traffic safety of the students/staff; and
4. Since the school board has provided crossing guards at an additional cost to the budget the request is to provide additional support or solution to this intersection in the near future to avoid a severe accident that could be deadly.
