Subject: Post Landowner Meeting Recap

An informational meeting was held on July 16th, 2021, to discuss the potential additions that were brought up at the June 11th, 2021 landowner meeting for Nobles, Jackson & Murray Counties Judicial Ditch No. 17 (JD 17). ISG presented the 4 options that were discussed at the previous meeting which are described below;

- Main Tile
 - o Remove size increase and decrease due to tile grades
 - o Improve tile to ½ inch/day drainage coefficient
- Branch A Tile
 - o Improve downstream end of tile to 30-inch tile size change
 - o Improve tile until Branch A4 in Section 12 of Graham Lake Township.
- Branch B Tile
 - o Replace main tile instead of supplementing

ISG and the landowners that were in attendance discussed these options as well as developed an additional option for Branch A tile. Therefore, the project scope has been amended to the following;

- Main Tile
 - o Improve tile from the main ditch to Branch E tile, where the increase and decrease in tile sizes stop due to grade changes. The proposed tile would consist of a 36-, 30- and 24-inch tile and have adequate depth for any future improvement.
- Branch B Tile
 - o Connect Branch B tile on the west side of CSAH 39. The proposed tile would consist of a 24-inch tile and have adequate depth for any future improvement.
- Branch A Tile
 - o Improve tile from the main ditch to the 30-inch tile in the SE ¼ of Section 1 of Dundee Township, where the increase and decrease in tile sizes stop due to grade changes. The proposed tile would consist of a 42-inch tile and have adequate depth for any future improvement.
