

**BEFORE THE NOBLES-MURRAY JOINT BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS, ACTING AS DRAINAGE AUTHORITY
FOR JD #12**

**Findings of Fact and Order Approving the
Redetermination of Benefits, Pursuant to
Minnesota Statutes 103E.351**

WHEREAS, the Nobles-Murray Joint Board of Commissioners, acting as Drainage Authority for JD #12, ordered the Redetermination of Benefits to be completed for JD #12; and

WHEREAS, viewers were appointed to prepare a Redetermination of Benefits' Report; and

WHEREAS, a Viewers' Report was filed with the Nobles County Auditor-Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 23, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. in the Farmers' Room of the Nobles County Government Center; and

WHEREAS, Zach Reker, the Nobles County Drainage System Coordinator, indicated that proper mailed notice had been sent to each landowner; and

WHEREAS, Bryan Murphy of H2Over Viewers, gave a general overview of the Redetermination of Benefits process; and

WHEREAS, Bryan Murphy then gave a specific Redetermination of Benefits' Report for Nobles-Murray JD #12; and

WHEREAS, the hearing was open for public comment and questions and there were questions concerning tile size.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on all of the evidence presented, the Nobles-Murray Joint Board of Commissioners, acting as Drainage Authority for JD #12, makes the following Findings of Fact and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Viewers' Report has been made and other proceedings have been completed under Minnesota Statutes 103E.
2. The Viewers' Report, attached as **Exhibit A**, is complete and correct.
3. The damages and benefits have been properly determined.


ORDER
