WHEREAS, the Nobles-Jackson County Joint Board of Commissioners, acting as Drainage Authority for Nobles-Jackson County, Judicial Ditch #4, ordered the Redetermination of Benefits of Nobles-Jackson County, Judicial Ditch #4; and

WHEREAS, viewers were appointed to redetermine benefits for Nobles-Jackson County, Judicial Ditch #4; and

WHEREAS, a Viewers' Report was submitted to the Nobles-Jackson County Joint Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, a Redetermination Hearing was held on December 20, 2021, at 1:30 p.m., at the Worthington Event Center, located in Worthington, Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the appointed viewers gave the Viewers' Report concerning benefits and damages to Nobles-Jackson County, Judicial Ditch #4; and

WHEREAS, the Hearing was open for public comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the evidence presented, the Nobles-Jackson County Joint Board of Commissioners, acting as Drainage Authority for Nobles-Jackson County, Judicial Ditch #4, makes the following Findings of Fact and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. That the Viewers' Report made or amended and attached as **Exhibit A** has been made and other proceedings have been completed under Minnesota Statutes 103E.
