

**BEFORE THE NOBLES COUNTY BOARD OF

**Findings of Fact and order Approving  
Redetermination of Benefits, Pursuant to  
Minnesota Statutes 103E.351**

**WHEREAS**, the Nobles County Board of Commissioners, acting as Drainage Authority for Nobles County CD #6, ordered the Redetermination of Benefits, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 103E.351; and

**WHEREAS**, viewers were appointed and a Redetermination of Benefits' Report has been filed; and

**WHEREAS**, a Public Hearing was held on December 2, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., in the Nobles County Government Center, Farmers' Room, located in Worthington, Minnesota; and

**WHEREAS**, Dan Ruby, one of the duly appointed viewers gave the Viewers' Report for the Redetermination of Benefits for Nobles County Ditch #6; and

**WHEREAS**, Dan Ruby indicated that the net benefits for this system was \$5,125,694.99, with the damages for the buffer strip of \$66,170.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the hearing was open for public comment and there was no public comment.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, based on all the evidence presented and all reports filed, the Nobles County Board of Commissioners, acting as Drainage Authority for Nobles County CD #6, makes the following Findings of Fact and Order:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Viewers' Report has been made and other proceedings have been completed under Minnesota Statutes 103E.
2. The reports made or amended are complete and correct.

3. The damages and benefits have been properly determined.

**ORDER**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ordered that the Redetermination of Benefits for Nobles County Ditch #6, attached as **Exhibit A**, is hereby approved and shall be used in all subsequent proceedings regarding Nobles County CD #6.
