

VETERANS TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

The Nobles County DAV Transportation Program is here to assist Veterans who are in need of transportation to and from their scheduled VA appointments or paid VA appointments. The program is completely free for the veteran.

Established in 2017, the sole purpose of the Nobles County DAV Transportation Program is to assist Southwest Minnesota veterans with access to the medical benefits that they have earned at VA facilities or VA paid appointments. Through a partnership with the DAV, the Nobles County Veterans Service office provides a donated van that is stationed in Worthington and is coordinated by the DAV NW Transportation service (855) 277-9787.

Veterans who are ambulatory can access this service free of charge. Caregivers of veterans are more than welcome to ride along as well if they are required.
