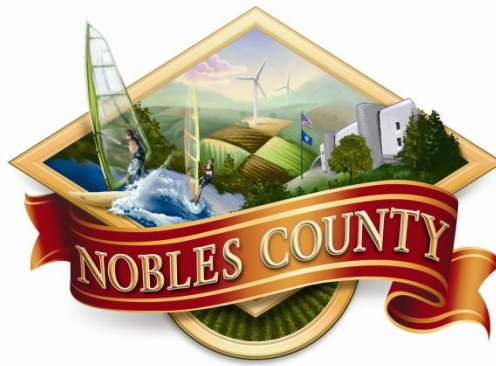

The low supply and great demand for vehicles and are creating real concerns for county departments. Other counties have already signed up to receive leased vehicles through Enterprise Fleet Management, Incorporated. Senior Account Executive Wong Nystrom is willing to explain Enterprise's services to the County Commissioners during the Work Session.

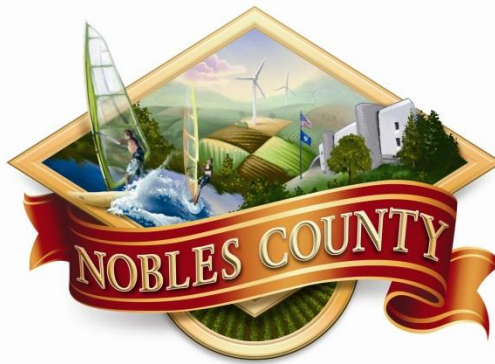
Discussion:
