The Owner intends to award a Stipulated Sum Single Prime Contract from the bids received for this Project. Immediately after specified closing time, Bids will be opened, read aloud and tabled for review and subsequent action. All interested parties are invited to attend.

Project Description:

Replacement of an existing indoor 175 kW diesel generator with a new indoor 400 kW diesel generating unit. The new generator will be located in an indoor space with provisions for intake and exhaust airflow systems and fuel day tank system. In addition, the existing main switchboard would need to be upgraded to facilitate utilizing the generator to back-up the complete facility.

Project Completion Time:

The Work is to commence upon execution of the Contract and is to be Substantially Complete by July 23, 2024.
